


D. (U) PERU: DOES FUJIMÓRI'S UNDFFICIAL ADVISOR CONTROL THE PERUVIAN NATIONAL INTELLIGENCE COMMUNITY?

(1) (G,NF)(U)CCORDING TO PERUVIAN PRESIDENT ALBERTO FUJIMORI, <u>VLADIMIRO MONTESINOS TORRES</u>, PERUVIAN EX-ARMY ARTILLERY CAPTAIN AND NOW AN ATTORNEY, ONLY ACTS AS A PERSONAL LEGAL ADVISOR TO THE PRESIDENT. YET FROM THE START OF FUJIMORI'S PRESIDENCY LAST JULY, PERU'S MILITARY LEADERS AND MEDIA HAVE SPECULATED THAT MONTESINOS IS PLAYING A MUCH MORE INFLUENTIAL ROLE IN MATTERS OF STATE THAN FUJIMORI HAS BEEN WILLING TD ADMIT.

(2) (C/NF(U)ONE HYPOTHESIS IS THAT MONTESINOS HAS INFLUENCED PRESIDENTIAL APPOINTMENTS TO HIGH POSITIONS IN BOTH THE CIVILIAN AND MILITARY SECTORS OF GOVERNMENT. AS A RESULT, HE NOW ENJOYS DIRECT AND INDIRECT CONTROL OVER MAJOR NODES OF THE PERUVIAN INTELLIGENCE AND SECURITY SERVICES. DURING FUJIMORI'S FIRST YEAR IN OFFICE, PERUVIAN ARTILLERY OFFICERS WERE APPOINTED TO FILL THE THREE TOP POSITIONS OF THE NATIONAL INTELLIGENCE SERVICE (SIN), WHICH INCLUDE THE CHIEF, DEPUTY CHIEF, AND SECRETARY-GENERAL. A FOURTH ARTILLERY OFFICER WAS APPOINTED TO HEAD THE PERUVIAN ARMY INTELLIG-ENCE DIRECTORATE. OTHER ARTILLERY OFFICERS WERE NAMED TO HEAD VARIOUS ARMY POSTS. IN ADDITION, THE MINISTRIES OF DEFENSE AND INTERIOR ARE

REGRADED CONFIDENTIAL ON US JULY 2000 BY USAINSCOM FOL/PA Auth Para 4-102, DOD 5200.1R

HEADED RESPECTIVELY BY RETIRED AND ACTIVE DUTY ARTILLERY OFFICERS.

(3) (G/REL UK/CA)(W)MONTEIINOS HAS NOT LIMITED HIMSELF TO PROMOTING ARTILLERY OFFICERS. ALTHOUGH NOT AN OFFICIAL PRESIDENTIAL APPOINTEE, HE MAINTAINS AN OFFICE AT SIN HEADQUARTERS AND HAS USE OF A GOVERNMENT CAR WITH PROTECTIVE ESCORTS.

(4) (C/NF(())MONTESINOS GRADUATED FROM THE PERUVIAN MILITARY ACADEMY (ESCUELA MILITAR DE CHORRILLOS) AND WAS COMMISSIONED AS AN ARTILLERY OFFICER ON 1 JANUARY 1966. HOWEVER, HIS MILITARY CAREER WAS DERAILED IN THE 1970'S WHEN HE SERVED TIME IN PRISON IN CONNECTION WITH CHARGES OF ESPIONAGE. HIS LINKS TO THE FUJIMORI FAMILY ARE SAI? TO PRECEDE THE ELEVATION OF ALBERTO FUJIMORI TO THE PRESIDENCY.

(5) (C/REL UK/CA)(W)DN 20 JUNE 1991, GENERAL LUIS PALJMINO RODRIGUEZ, FORMER ARMY INSPECTOR GENERAL, EMERGED AS A SOMEWHAT IMPROBABLE LEADER OF AN EVENTUAL ANTI-MONTESINOS MOVEMENT. WEARING BULLETPROOF VEST AND CARRYING A SIDE ARM, HE PAID A VISIT TO THE RESIDENCE OF A MEMBER OF THE USDAO, LIMA, TO WARN AGAINST MONTESINOS' INTENTIONS TO FRUSTRATE JOINT US-PERUVIAN COUNTERDRUG EFFORTS. MONTESINOS' VISIT OCCURRED ONLY ONE DAY AFTER HE HAD BEEN ORDERED BY THE PRESIDENTIAL PALACE TO LEAVE PERU AND RETURN TO HIS ASSIGNMENT IN THE MIDDLE EAST, WHICH HE IS OFFICIALLY SCHEDULED TO COMPLETE BY

(6) (C)(W)THE CURRENT HEAD OF PERUVIAN NAVAL INTELLIGENCE IS ALSO KNOWN TO BE CRITICAL OF MONTESINOS. LAST YEAR HE LEAKED TO THE US MISSION ADVANCE INFORMATION ABOUT THE MASS FIRINGS OF PERUVIAN POLICE OFFICERS THAT TOOK PLACE ON THE EVE OF THE JULY 1990 PRESIDENTIAL INAUGURATION.

(7) (C)(U)ANALYST COMMENTS: AS A FORMER ARMY OFFICER, MONTESINOS IS WELL-PLACED TO ADVISE PRESIDENT FUJIMORI ON HOW FAR HE CAN DEVIATE FROM THE TRADITIONAL PROMOTION HIERARCHY TO SECURE HIS HOLD OV<u>ER THE COUNTRY'S MILITARY</u> AND POLICE COMPONENTS.





B. (U) WHO IS CONTROLLING WHOM?

(1) Corner according to three retired peruvian army officers, president fujimori is in the hip pocket of the national intelligence service (servicio intelegencia nacional-sin) and is particularly influenced by <u>vladimiro montesinos torres</u>, currently the number two man in the sin. Retired army general edwin diaz is the chief of the sin, but in title only. Montesinos, a former military man whose career ended abruptly, was also an attorney for the peruvian first lady's questionable real estate deals, and a campaign advisor who successfully counseled fujimori on the means to counter his opposition's personal attacks.

(2) (2) (2) (2) RETIRED GENERALS EDGARDO MERCADO JARRIN, FORMER ARMY COMMANDER AND MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS, LUIS F. CISNEROS VIZQUERA, FORMER ARMY COMMANDER, AND SINECIO JARAMA DAVILLA, FORMER DIRECTOR OF THE ARMY STAFF, AGREED THAT THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN FUJIMORI AND THE SIN, WITH ARMY INTELLIGENCE ON THE PERIPH-ERY WAS EXTRAORDINARY - A SITUATION IN WHICH THE INTELLIGENCE APPARA-TUS IS IN EFFECT RUNNING THE STATE. ACCORDING TO THE THREE, THE SIN IS OBSESSED WITH THE POLITICAL PARTY ALIANZA POPULAR REVOLUCIONARIA AMERICANA (APRA-POPULAR ALLIANCE FOR THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION) ACTING IN CONCERT WITH THE MOVIMIENTO REVOLUCIONARIO TUPAC AMARU (MRTA). THE GENERALS WERE OF THE OPINION THAT MONTESIHOS CONVINCED FUJIMORI TO FIRE A LONG LIST OF SENIOR MILITARY AND POLICE FIGURES FOR CONNECTIONS WITH APRA, CORRUPTION, AND DRUG TRAFFICKING; HOWEVE (,THEY SUSPECT MANY OF, THOSE CASHIERED HAD CROSSED MONTESINOS IN THE PAST.


(3) (3) (C/NF) ONE OF THE GENERALS OPINED THAT "TK_C PERUVIAN CIA CANNOT DOMINATE THE PERUVIAN STATE," AND THAT THE ARMED FORCES WOULD INTERVENE AND "DECAPITATE" THE INTELLIGENCE STRUCTURE AT SOME POINT. THE OTHER TWO AGREED AND INDICATED THAT, AS MORE BECOMES KNOWN ABOUT MONTESINOS, THE FUJIMORI ADMINISTRATION WILL FACE MORE CRITICISM. IT WILL THEN BE UP TO THE PRESIDENT TO DEIDE WHAT COURSE OF ACTION TO TAKE.



THE OPINIONS OF OTHERS. PRESIDENT FUJIMORI WAS BASICALLY A POLITICAL UNKNOWN PRIOR TO HIS ELECTION, AND PERHAPS HE HAS SURROUNDED HIMSELF WITH ADVISORS WHOSE PERSONAL GOALS AND AMBITIONS OUTWEIGH THOSE OF THE STATE. ALTHOUGH THE OFFICERS HAVE BEEN OUT OF THE MAINSTREAM FOR A WHILE, ALL ARE CAPABLE OF WIELDING SOME INFLUENCE. FOR EXAMPLE, GENERAL MERCADO IS CURRENTLY THE DIRECTOR OF THE INSTITUTO PERUANO DE ESTUDIOS GEOPOLITICOS Y ESTRATEGIOS (PERUVIAN INSTITUTE OF GEOPOLITICAL AND STRATEGIC STUDIES); GENERAL CISNEROS IS CURRENTLY A POLITICAL WRITER AND COMMENTATOR; AND GENERAL JARAMA, IS A FREE LANCE POLITICAL ANALYST. 



(1) (U) IN MID-OCTOBER, A LIMA NEWSPAPER PRINTED TWO ARTICLES DESCRIBING POLITICAL ESPIONAGE ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED BY THE PERUVIAN NATIONAL INTELLIGENCE SERVICE (SIN) AGAINST PERUVIAN CITIZENS ABROAD. ACCORDING TO THE ARTICLES, A PERUVIAN CONGRESSMAN HAS ACCUSED SIN AGENTS AND SPECIALLY TRAINED PERUVIAN ATTACHE OFFICERS OF RUNNING ESPIONAGE ACTIVITIES IN THE US FROM THE INTER-AMERICAN DEFENSE BOARD (IADB) IN WASHINGTON, DC. IN ADDITION, THE CONGRESSMAN ACCUSED SIN OF SURVEILLING MEMBERS OF PRESIDENT FUJIMORI'S OPPOSITION. THE ARTICLES EDITORIALIZED THAT THE CURRENT ADMINISTRATION CONSIDERS OPPOSITION CONGRESSMEN, JOURNALISTS, AND INTELLECTUAL DISSIDENTS IN PERU AND ABROAD ENEMIES OF THE STATE, WHILE SIN SHOULD BE TARGETING FOREIGN AGGRESSORS, NARCOTRAFFICKERS, AND TERRORISTS.


(2) (U) ANALYST COMMENTS:

(ii) (A) (SZNF) PREVIOUS REPORTING DESCRIBED AN OVERSEAS SIN INTELLIGENCE NETWORK MANAGED BY A CLOSE FUJIMORI ADVISOR, <u>VLADIMIRO MONTESINOS</u>. THE COLLECTION EFFORT IS STAFFED BY AT LEAST 17 RETIRED MILITARY OFFICERS NOW WORKING FOR SIN. THESE COLLECTORS OPERATE FROM DIPLOMATIC MISSIONS, SOME UN ER COMMERCIAL ATTACHE COVER. SIN NETWORKS ARE ACTIVE IN BOLIVIA, BRAZIL, CHILE, COLOMBIA, ECUADOR, SOUTH KOREA, AND THE US. THE CLOSE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN FUJIMORI AND MONTESINOS SUGGESTS THAT THIS NETWORK RESPONDS DIRECTLY TO PRESIDENTIAL REQUIREMENTS. THE NETWORK COULD ALSO HAVE OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES, SUCH AS WEAPONS ACQUISITION AND DISINFORMATION. (ANALYST: (0)(7)(5)







